

How Consonant Phonemes Change

- *Deaspiration - stop consonant produced with less air at end of word or in a consonant blend (sdak for stack, sgin for skin)*
- *Nasal deletion (or omission) in final blends (bup for bump, wet for went, bag for bang)*
- *Affrication of /t/ or /d/ before /r/ or /y/ (chrane for train, jrag for drag, fucher for future)*
- *Tongue flap between a stressed and an unstressed vowel (bodl for bottle, wodr for water)*
